PROMOTING MENTAL HEALTH

Programs focus on prevention strategies, promoting wellness and resilience, as well as ensuring access to mental health treatment, crisis services and other supports.

MEETING BASIC NEEDS: Transportation

Programs provide transportation for older adults and persons with disabilities.

MEETING BASIC NEEDS: Healthcare

Programs reduce barriers to accessing essential health services, including dental care, home visiting, hospice and palliative care.

Programs focus on substance abuse prevention, including developing assets and promoting resilience, as well as reducing barriers to treatment and supporting recovery.
